

School Council Job Description

The job of a school council representative is to listen to ideas brought up in your class and decide with your classmates which ideas need to go to school council. The ideas make up the agenda of things to talk to other children about at meetings. You must remember to let your classmates know what you have talked about and ask them to get involved in finding solutions. You will be responsible for representing the school at events and assemblies as well as talking to visitors to the school. You will wear a 'School Council' badge.
