


Classic collection of nonsense poetry from the likes of Spike Milligan, Lewis Carroll, Edward Lear and Ogden Nash.


Two of Valerie Bloom's popular collections available together in one volume. A diverse collection of warm, witty poems that read aloud very well.


Imaginative and often humorous poems inspired by the strange creatures of the natural world. Lower KS2.

An engaging, wide-ranging collection of non-rhyming poetry. Includes advice on how to write and perform non-rhyming poems.





A collection of new poems and old favourites by Chrissie Gittins. Some are humorous and some are more serious, inviting reflection or discussion. All are top quality.





Alphabetically arranged collection of poems about animals with a 'scrapbook' style format. Aimed at Upper Key Stage 2.



Accessible collection of poems, illustrated by the author, on a variety of themes.




Impressive collection of poems by a new writer, covering themes of school, friendship, bullying and emotions. Useful topic support material but also appealing for leisure reading.






**Stevens, Roger**






