Dear parents/carers,

Sports Day – Monday 30th June 2025 (Reserve date – Monday 7th July 2025)

Timings for years 3, 4, 5 & 6: 9:10am start and 12.00pm finish (approximately)

Timings for EYFS, year 1 and year 2: 1:10pm start and 3:15pm finish (approximately).

Format of the day

- To start each session, children will rotate around four 'zones' on the school field, taking part in various events, earning points for their House Team. Parents/carers will be free to walk around the outside of the four zones and go from one zone to another, watching their child(ren) compete
- Once all the group events have been completed, parents / carers will be invited to gather on the other side of the track nearest to the school building ready to watch the 'plate races' (for children wanting to race but who didn't qualify for the finals) followed by the 'finals' (relay race and flat race - first heats will have taken place prior to the day). **As a reminder, parents must not cross the track**
- Finally we run a fun tug of war competition for children in years 3 to 6 only.

Lunchtime

Families are welcome to join the children for a picnic lunch on the field.

- At the end of the morning session, children in years 3, 4, 5 & 6 will go back into school to collect their lunch and wash their hands before returning to the school field for a picnic
- Children in EYFS, Y1 and Y2 will be brought out on to the field at midday - children will be released to parents from the left hand side of the field (Y1/2 classroom side) and teachers will wait until the children see a parent before dismissing them
- Children of those parents/carers who are unable to attend the picnic lunch will be supervised by staff
- **Please note that there will be no hot meal option for Sports day but a picnic will be available to order on the morning of Sports Day.**

At 1.00pm, all children will return to classes with their teachers to be registered. Children in EYFS, year 1 and year 2 will return to the field after the equipment has been set up. **Please support us by clearing up and packing away picnics / mats / chairs by 12.55pm.**

Other important information:

- Children should arrive at school at the usual time, they will change into their PE kit (with t-shirt of their House Team colour)
- Children should be appropriately kitted out if the weather is hot – sunhat and a water bottle is essential
- Families attending in the morning can make their way around to the school field straight after drop off
- After school / breakfast club will be running as usual.
