13/3/26 Year 3 have been immersed in Science week and reading for pleasure following our author visit. In science we have been investigating forces focusing on friction as well as experimenting with different types of magnets. In Maths we have moved onto our measure unit which has helped us to record our science experiments accurately. In English next week, the children will be writing a rousing speech to persuade the Icenii tribe to fight against the mighty Roman army. Our maths work for the last week has been all about money.
