Sports Write-Up

Cross Country Event – Wednesday 4th December 2024

We would like to commend the fantastic effort displayed by all participants in the recent cross country qualifiers and Santa fun run. It is truly impressive to note that the event had 60 children per race, highlighting the level of talent and commitment we have within our community. We also had 40 children represent the school in the Santa fun run.

In the Year 4 girls qualifier, we saw outstanding performances from Ruthie, who finished 4th, and Lola in 5th place, followed by Beth in 19th, Scarlett in 20th, Darcie in 43th and Martha 45th. The Year 4 boys also demonstrated great spirit, with Idris finishing 17th, Tyren closely following in 20th, Kit in 26th, Miles in 36th, Grayson in 50th and Amos in 55th.

The Year 5/6 qualifiers were equally remarkable. In the girls category, Alice secured 4th place, with Ayla in 5th and Livia in 6th. Year R

The children have reached the end of their first full term with us in Early Years and what a jam packed term it has been. Year 1

Year 2

What a fantastic few weeks we have had with the children; it has been very busy, but lots of fun. The children thoroughly enjoyed making their Moon buggies for Bob the Man on the Moon and were able to identify what had gone well when making them and what needed to be improved (wheels not falling off was a common one!). They loved their visit to the Yurt on Monday afternoon, where they engaged in some very festive art activities and enjoyed listening to a Christmas story. In RE this half term the children have learnt about the significance of candles and light during Hanukkah and Advent, they have made their own mini advent wreaths from clay which they will be bringing home at the end of the week. We would like to wish you all a very merry Christmas and look forward to seeing the children again in January after a well deserved break.

Year 3

As we complete our Autumn term, the children have been busy finishing off their history and art projects. Our inside and outside pre-history days were a big success! The children were able to get very hands-on, trying different skills and techniques for the first time: Cave painting, making their own charcoal, soap sculpting and building their own round houses. We have used links to history in our English lessons and the children have each written an information text about Stonehenge. In Maths, please continue to practice 3x, 4x, 5x tables at home and use the children's TT Rock Stars log-ons at home. We'd also like to thank the children for all of their festive pictures, craft and cards and for thank you for your generous Christmas gifts! We wish you all a Merry Christmas and best wishes for the new year. We hope you all have a restful and peaceful break, and we look forward to seeing you all soon!

Year 4

Year 4 have had a busy and exciting few weeks! In English, we wrote persuasive letters, practicing how to convince others on various topics. In Science, we investigated sound and pitch, even creating our own stethoscopes using spoons!

In Art, we explored mark making and created beautiful wax resist designs, revealing colorful backgrounds underneath. We also learned about Christmas traditions in Spain and how to wish each other a Merry Christmas in Spanish – “¡Feliz Navidad!” We even sang the famous Christmas song together.

To finish off the term, Year 4 enjoyed a fantastic trip to the pantomime at Henry Beaufort School, where they watched a fun performance by the Year 9 students. It's been a joyful end to the term, and we wish all our families a very Merry Christmas!

Year 5

What a whirlwind the last few weeks of term have been! As we draw to a close, we are reminded of the exhilarating experiences we have shared. Year 5 went on an engaging visit to the planetarium and science centre, where curiosity, exploration and fun was had by all. We were fortunate enough to have an inspiring space talk delivered by one of our own parents, Dr Jen Gupta, who shared her vast knowledge and passion for astronomy with us. In our mathematics lessons, we have continued to delve further into fractions. Our focus has been on finding equivalent fractions, converting improper and mixed numbers and ordering of fractions with different denominators.

In English, we have successfully completed our book "Cloudbusting," where the students crafted their own narratives. Employing the technique of 'show, not tell', they have skilfully described both good and bad characters, demonstrating their creative writing abilities. As this term has drawn to a close, we have celebrated the festive season with a flurry of Christmas activities. Our two carol concerts at St Barnabas radiated joy and community spirit. Additionally, the Christmas activities in the yurt provided a delightful atmosphere for festive fun. Our students showcased their talents in performance poetry, and to top it all off, the much-anticipated "Weeke's Got Talent." was once again a hit. As we move into the Christmas break, we wish all our children and their families a wonderful festive season and a Happy New Year. May it be filled with joy, rest, and rejuvenation.

Year 6

This term has been full of exciting learning opportunities! In English, we explored the Christmas Truce of WWI through creative writing. The children wrote compelling diary entries presenting an opposing view of the truce and crafted interview transcripts imagining conversations with WWI soldiers about this remarkable event. In maths, our focus was on completing the *Converting Units* and *Position and Direction* units. The children developed their skills in these areas with confidence and accuracy. In gymnastics, we delved into counterbalances and counter tension, fostering teamwork and core strength. We also wrapped up our netball unit with some fantastic games, showcasing the children's progress and teamwork. The children completed their stunning mixed-media poppy artwork, demonstrating creativity and attention to detail. We concluded our






